>>From the 10 FW - Head east to San Bernardino. Exit 80 University St. Turn Left On Univ. St. Turn right on Lugonia Ave. Continue onto Mentone Blvd. Continue onto CA-38/ Mill Creek Rd. Take slight right Valley of the Falls Dr. When entering Forest Home Retreat Camp look for signs Man vs. Wild / Man Camp. Creekside Sight.

>>From the 210 FW - Head east to San Bernardino. Exit San Bernardino Ave. Take left on San Bernardino Ave. Take right on Tennessee St. Take a left on Lugonia Ave. Continue onto Mentone Blvd. Continue on to CA-38/ Mill Creek Rd. Take slight right Valley of the Falls Dr. When entering Forest Home Retreat Camp look for signs Man vs. Wild / Man Camp. Creekside Sight.
