Read John 6:25-31,35-70

- 1.) Do you embarrass easily? What kinds of things embarrass you?
- 2.) Talk about a time when you were embarrassed by a friend or family member. How did you respond?
- 3.) Read John 6:56–61. Are there things Jesus said or did that offend you or that used to offend you? Explain.
- 4.) In the message, Peter said, “Questions tend to complicate things. Considering the options simplifies them.” Do you agree? Why or why not?
- 5.) When has following Jesus been inconvenient, embarrassing, or costly for you? What did you do?
- 6.) Is transition, trouble, or temptation currently getting in the way of your ability to follow Jesus? What can this group do to support you?

When transition, trouble, or temptation cause you to question your faith, consider the options. When you do, the fog will begin to lift. You will find the courage and strength to believe.
