In Colossians, Paul suggested that we leverage this approach beyond our marriage, friendships, and parenting, by bringing this principle into our interactions with everyone-including those who don't believe what we believe. Discussion Questions:

When we share our beliefs or ideas with others, our conversations can quickly become confrontational. Jesus often talked with people he had little in common with, yet somehow he was able to find common ground in order to "break the ice" and make a difference. People genuinely liked him and wanted to hear more of what he had to say. We too can have those kinds of conversations and earn that kind of influence if we choose to make a difference instead of a point.

 What are some of the best and worst "icebreaker" questions you have asked or someone has asked you? What makes an icebreaker question "good" or "bad"?
Share an "icebreaking" moment from your life - a time when someone used the power of conversation to influence you in a positive way.
