- 1.) How would you define "grace"? Why might it be a confusing concept in today's culture?
- 2.) What are some of the most powerful images of grace that you've experienced in your life?
- 3.) What happens when conversations have too much salt and not enough grace? Is there such a thing as "too much grace"?
- 4.) Read John 8:111. How does Jesus capture the right mix of grace and salt?
- 5.) Why is it wiser to lead with grace than with salt?
- 6.) What are some current areas of life where you could show more grace?



Moving Forward

Finding the right mix of grace and salt (truth) can be challenging. But more often that not, approaching someone with grace is the precursor to an honest conversations that is receptive to a seasoning of salt.

So be full of grace. Then season with salt. And see if the ice melts away.
