In Mark 5, Jesus heals the demon-possessed man, whom Gavin calls "Larry." When "Larry" asked to leave with Jesus, he was told, "Go home to your own people and tell them how much the Lord has done for you, and how he has had mercy on you." What impact do you think Larry's story had on those who heard it?

Peter said, "Christians aren't called to have an answer to everything, but to be an answer to everyone." Do you agree with this statement? Why or why not?

Who can you share your personal story with? What can this group do to support you?

Moving Forward

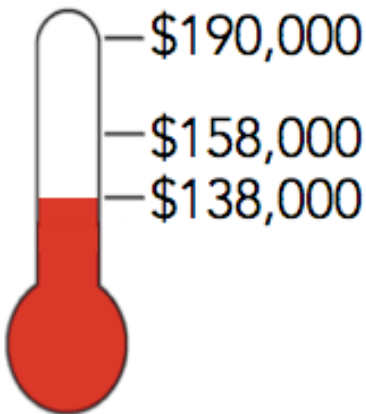
It is hard to resist someone's personal story. Facts can be disputed, but stories must be noted. Your personal story is an answer for everyone.
