We all probably remember playing the game “Simon Says” when we were little. Trying our best to mimic the correct actions while keeping from doing the wrong ones. It seemed like no matter how hard we tried, after time we got mixed up and ended up hearing “Simon didn’t say...” In this quiet time, we are looking at the writing of a guy named Solomon who was said to be the wisest man that ever lived. Lets examine his advice on how to live a healthy life and try to follow what **Solomon Says**.

**PROVERBS 3**

1. List three other benefits of wisdom in your life.
2. In verse 5, we are commanded to not lean on our understanding but to trust God. In what areas of your life do you need to trust God rather than yourself?
3. Verse 9 tells us to honor God with our wealth. Do you give on a weekly basis? What promises are made to those who honor God with their wealth?
4. In verses 27-32, there are specific ways we are to treat other people. Evaluate these areas in your life. Which ones do you need to grow the most?

**PROVERBS 4**

1. Solomon emphasizes again how important wisdom is in our lives. In verse 5, Solomon says, “get wisdom, get knowledge.” How much are you willing to give up in order to get wisdom?
2. What are some easy things you can do to go after getting wisdom?
3. Why does Solomon say to guard our hearts above everything else?
4. This month, what areas of weakness do you need to guard your heart in? How can you practically do this?

**PROVERBS 7**

1. Go back through the first 7 chapters and count the number of times we’re told to listen, follow and accept the commands we have been given.
2. What does Solomon teach you about your need for the Bible and people who hold you accountable in your life?
3. How teachable are you? Ask someone you trust and is spiritual this question today. Make a decision about an area of your life you need to listen more, follow better and accept discipling in your life.
