## **Discussion Questions**

The Circle Maker: Praying is like Planting

Share with the group a life experience where you had to wait patiently, much longer than you wanted to wait. How did this shape and form who you are today? How would things have changed if it happened quickly?

- 1. Read **James 5:16** Who are some the 'righteous men' who have prayed for the Lighthouse church years ago and made it what it is today? Share their names. Honor them.
- 2. Read **Daniel 6:1-10** What are some of the ways that life, and even our culture, can get in the way of us praying and devoting our time and passion we need to this important ministry? What can we do to notice and get around this roadblocks to prayer?
- 3. Daniel faced Jerusalem so he could be pointed in the direction of his dream as he prayed. What are some ways we can face get in proximity to our dreams desired answered prayers so we can pray with greater passion?
- 4.Daniel's physical posture was a mirror of his mental and spiritual posture. What are some ways we can posture our bodies as we pray (use examples from scripture) that will help our bodies as we pray that will help us stay focused and concentrated on what we are praying for?
- 5. Read **Daniel 10:1-3** We see here that Daniel fasted for three weeks. Why did he do it? What are some areas of our lives where we need to get more desperate about 'praying harder' fasting? Are you open to fasting for a period of time for your prayer circles? What about a 'Daniel fast?'
