Discussion Questions

1. As a kid, did you tend to follow the crowd or go your own way? Please explain.
2. Why is it so easy for people to look at everyone else's life and assume they want to be like everyone else?
3. Where have you seen a series of small, unwise choices turn into big regret in someone's life? Why was it difficult for them to see the potential consequences of their choices?
4. **Read 1 Corinthians 6:18-20.** Talk about some ways that the consequences of sinning against your own body are unique compared to other kinds of sin.
5. Given our cultural landscape, does the advice to flee instead of flirt seem realistic to you? Why or why not?
