Discussion Questions

1. Have you ever bought something brand new that you really took good care of in the beginning but over time you gave it less attention? What was it?
2. In the message, Mike said, "When something becomes routine or normal, it has the potential to lose its power and meaning." Do you believe that statement? Why or why not?
3. As you consider communion, has it become a normal routine in your relationship with God that has lost its power and meaning in your life? Explain your answer.
4. **Read Luke 24:30-35.** What became clear when Jesus took the bread, blessed it, broke it and gave it to these men?
5. What does communion or the breaking of the bread have the power to reveal in your life? Out of the four stages that were mentioned, what stage are you in currently?
6. What is one thing you can do on a weekly basis to make sure communion doesn't lose its power in your life?
