Discussion Questions

- In what ways do you see power, prestige, and possessions abused in our culture?
- Talk about a time when you've seen someone treat his or her personal influence as a temporary stewardship from God. How did other people react to him or her?
- Read Daniel 5:26.** What does it mean to you that God has numbered the days of your power, prestige, and possessions?
- What is one area in which you're regularly tempted to look down on others—education, possessions, physical appearance, influence, experience, intelligence? What is the cost of giving in to your pride?
- Think about the areas of your life where you have the most influence, power, and prestige. What would it look like for you to treat those areas like a temporary stewardship from God for which you are accountable?
- What is one thing you can do this week to remind your pride that you are just a steward of God's blessings?

Moving Forward

When you see someone with less—intelligence, education, money, or influence—you're tempted to think more highly of yourself. Pause for a moment and tell your pride, "The Most High is sovereign over all the kingdoms." Remind your pride that everything God has given you is a stewardship. It's temporary. You are accountable for how you use it.
