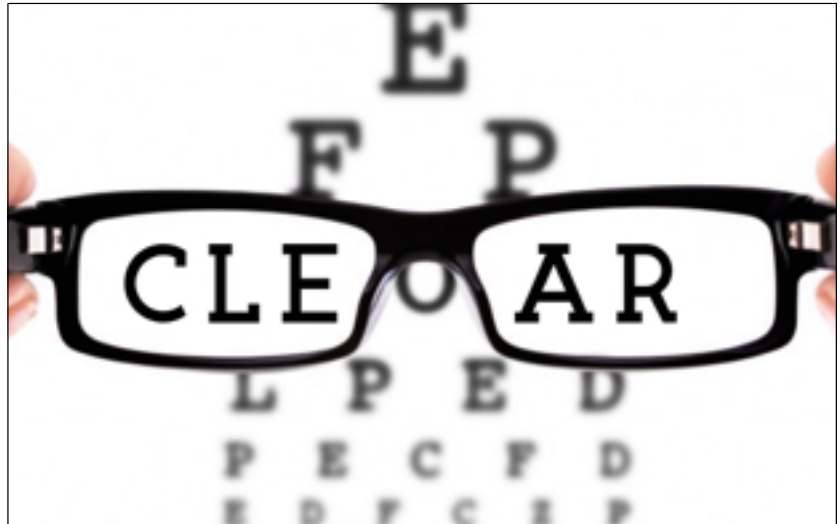

**Discussion Questions**

1. What are some quirks that are easy for you to spot in other people's lives, but are difficult to spot in your own life?
2. In the same way, its easy to look at the church and point out all of the issues and challenges. Agree or disagree?

6. What is one practical thing you can do this week to be devoted to the body of Christ instead of focusing on its shortcomings? Pray that the Holy Spirit would fill you with the desire to love your brothers and sisters in Christ.
