
Introduction

Review that true, saving faith involves Hearing, Believing and Obeying the Bible

- Disciples are called out of darkness into light
 <u>1 Peter 2:9-10</u>
- Not Saved/Not a Disciple/Non-Christian = Darkness/Not God's people/No Mercy
 Saved/Christian/Disciple = Light, People of God, Mercy
- Every person is either saved or lost. There is no twilight zone. Where are you?

Lost

- Sin separates us from God.....
- In order for a man to have a relationship with God the wall must be broken down, sin must be forgiven



- The point in time sin is forgiven is when a person is saved
- - A good moral life does not save you. You cannot earn your salvation by making up for sins with good deeds

Light


God

- Faith in the blood of Jesus saves you
- God is serious about sin, because it separates us from him
- Sin is serious, so it is important to get a clear picture of what is sin
 - Sins of Commission...... Galatians 5:19-21
 - Sins of Omission.....<u>James 4:17</u>
 - Sins of the Heart...... <u>Mark 7:20-23</u>
- Suggest writing a personal journal to better understand one's sinful nature

Salvation

- Born again (v. 3), born of water and spirit (v. 5), born again (v. 7)..........(John 3:1-7)
 Personal decision as an adult
- - Jesus is from God (v. 22)
 - Everyone is responsible for the crucifixion of Christ (v. 23, 36).
 - All have sinned
 - \circ Jesus raised physically from the dead (v. 24)
 - Jesus is Lord and Christ (v. 36)
- Response of people
 - Cut to the heart: What shall we do?
- Once the people HEAR and BELIEVE, what do they do?.....Acts 2:38-42
 - REPENT (Greek = to turn after feeling "cut to the heart")
 - **BE BAPTIZED** (Greek = to be immersed)

BAPTISM



- \circ \quad The point in time people are saved is when their sins are forgiven
- \circ $\,$ Holy Spirit given to each who responded, power to live as God commands $\,$
