Repentance and Baptism

2 Corinthians 7:10-11

Q: What is the difference between "Godly" and "Worldly Sorrow?" (sadness)

Godly Sorrow produces repentance, leading to salvation.

Worldly sorrow is characterized by depression, shame, inward focus and frustration.

Godly Sorrow is characterized by indignation, alarm, and a readiness for life change.

Acts 2:36-41

Q: What was their response? (v37)

O: Why were they cut to the heart?

- · Repent means to have a complete U-turn in your life.
- Baptism is complete immersion in water.
- The purpose of baptism is to receive the forgiveness of sins and to receive the Holy Spirit.
- The Holy Spirit is the indwelling of God's presence in your life.
- It is a promise for everyone to be in the grace of God and have a relationship with Him
- Q: Why did Peter plead with them to be urgent?


Romans 6:1-4

- Baptism is the participation in the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ. (not symbolic)
- Diagram: Jesus Death and Baptism
- · The point in time that sins are forgiven is when a repentant believer is baptized.

James 5:16

Q: What can help us heal?

- Confess your sins and pray for each other.
- · A lifestyle of confession frees us from guilt.
